The resource fee is non-refundable for students who administratively drop or withdraw from a class after the drop deadline. Students who are registered for courses with no required textbooks, or if there is no use of the Textbook Butler for whatever reason, a lower resource fee of \$40 per credit hour will apply. The resource fee is capped at \$100 for the student teaching course.

Courses must be dropped before the drop deadline in order to receive a full reversal of tuition and fees. Students are financially and academically responsible for any course(s) not dropped by the drop deadline.

Note: Tuition and fees may be subject to change without notice.

Tuition Refund Policy

- If you drop a course <u>before the first day of the module</u>, you will receive a 100% refund of your tuition and refund of the technology fee. The administration fee is <u>non-refundable</u>.
- If you drop a course <u>after the class starts but before the drop date</u>, you will receive a 75% refund of your tuition only. All fees are non-refundable.
- If you drop a course <u>after the drop date</u>, tuition and fees are <u>non-refundable</u>.
